Parent & Carer Focus Group

As we start to move out of lockdown, we are now in a position to reprioritise and once again focus on the journey of school improvement. Over the past twelve months I have had the opportunity to speak with many parents and carers and a common theme is a desire for parents and carers to be more informed about the day to day life of their child in school and to have an opportunity to work in partnership to improve the life chances of their children.

- Be an advocate for children's learning and development at Uffculme
- Explore, with the school, ways in which communication with parents and the wider community can be developed
- Support and be a visible presence at various school events

We are keen that this group represents the diverse population of the school and all ages of pupils. Please be assured that just because you may not have had any experience of working with schools since you yourself were at school does not mean you do not have something to contribute.
